Day 1 BANGALORE - TRIVANDRUM

This morning depart for flight to Trivandrum.

Upon arrival at Trivandrum Airport, a Meetings and More representative will meet you as you EXIT the ARRIVALS TERMINAL building after which you would be transferred to your hotel in Kovalam (15 Kms/approx 30 min).

Check in to the hotel.

Rest day is free for leisure to enjoy the hotel and beautiful Kovalam beach and SPA (on direct payment basis).

Overnight at the hotel.

Day 2 KOVALAM - TRIVANDRUM - KOVALAM

Buffet breakfast at the hotel



Today, you will proceed for tour to **Trivandrum**. Your tour highlights include a visit to the **Padmanabha Swamy Temple** (Open: 0415 - 0515 hrs, 0645 - 0715 hrs, 0830 - 1115 hrs, 1145 -1200 hrs, 1700 - 1815 hrs, 1845- 1930 hrs) - the temple is located inside the East Fort. Dedicated to Lord Vishnu, the temple is a blend of the Kerala and Dravidian styles of architecture and is known for its mural

paintings and stone carvings. *Only Hindus are allowed inside the temple. Dress code: Men - Dhoti; Women - Sari and blouse; Napier Museum & Art Gallery* (Open 1000 - 1645 hours, Closed on Monday, Wednesday forenoons, January 26th, August 15th, Thiruvonam and Mahanavami) - built in the 19th century, this

Indo - Saracenic structure boasts a natural air conditioning system and houses a rare collection of archaeological and historic artefacts, bronze idols, ancient

ornaments, a temple chariot and ivory carvings; **Sree Chithra Art Gallery** (Open 1000 - 1645 hrs. Closed on Monday & Wednesday forenoons) - located near the Napier Museum, this art gallery displays select paintings of Raja Ravi Varma, Svetlova and Nicholas Roerich and exquisite works from the Rajput, Mughal and Tanjore schools of art in India; **The Zoological Park** (Open 0900 - 1815 hours, Closed on Monday) - one of the first zoos in India, it is located in a well-planned botanical garden. With huge trees like frangipani and jacaranda dotting the sprawling lawns and wild fowl swimming in the lake, it is like a small jungle in the heart of the city. A reptile house with different species of snakes is also located in the premises; **The Kanakakunnu Palace** - the palace and its sprawling grounds are today the venue for many cultural meets and programmes and the **University Observatory** - located at the highest point in the city, near the Museum complex 60 metres above sea level, one can have a bird's eye view of the city from here.

Return back to your hotel in Kovalam.

Day 3

KOVALAM

Buffet breakfast at hotel.

Full day city tour of Kanyakumari where Arabian sea Indian Ocean and Bay of Bangal meets at a point. Kanyakumari, also known as Cape Comorin, is the 'Land's End' of India. The three seas - the Bay of Bengal, the Indian Ocean and the Arabian Sea meet here and a dip in their confluence is considered holy. It has a great spiritual significance for the Hindus. It's dedicated to goddess Devi Kanya, a form of Parvati, the consort of Shiva. Kanya Kumari is essentially a Hindu pilgrim centre, renowned for its exotic sunrises and sunsets over the horizon. Chaitra Purnima (Tamil for the April Full Moon) is one of the best times to experience the sunset and moonrise over the ocean simultaneously.

Visit **Kumari Amman Temple** - is the shore temple dedicated to the virgin goddess Devi Kanyakumari (Parvati), who stands guard over the country. The legend of this temple is as romantic as the place itself. The temple is built at the spot where the goddess is believed to have done penance and waited for her consort Lord Shiva



to come and claim her hand in marriage. Also visit **Gandhi Memorial** -which is raised at the spot where his ashes were kept for public darshan (viewing) before they were immersed in the sea. The memorial resembles an Orissan temple and was designed so that on Gandhi's birthday (2nd October), the sun's rays fall on the place where his ashes were kept. **Vivekananda Memorial** - is located on two rocky islands about 400m offshore. Swami Vivekanda meditated here in 1892 before setting out as one of India's most important religious crusaders. The mandapam (pillared hall) built here in his memory in 1970 reflects architectural styles from all over the country.

Return to hotel and overnight at hotel.
